This club calf prospect auction helps raise funds for KJLA scholarships

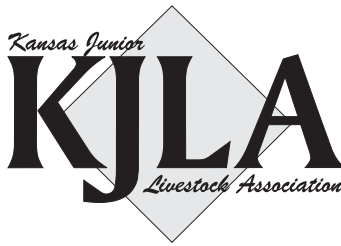
Plan & Perform a Kansas Ag educational session at KJLS
