Agriculture Council of 100 Goals

The Council of 100 will prioritize common sense workforce policies as a part of immigration and border security legislation and executive actions:

- Protect Existing Workforce Ag Employers are experiencing a labor shortage that threatens American food security. Protecting and maintaining the existing workforce is critical. This means pathways to citizenship to undocumented workers who have no criminal records, have been working and paying taxes, and who occupy critical workforce roles.
- **H2A Reform** Large proportions of farmers are currently unable to use the H2A guest worker program due to the year-round production of dairy, livestock, and some growing operations. Access to multi-year guest worker visas is vital if all sectors of agriculture are going to fill labor needs. Modernizing the application process would also help farmers by cutting program cost, and removing unnecessary red tape.
- Improved Access to Green Cards Over time, returning guest workers become invaluable assets and members of the management team. For those that want to, it is critical for long term success of farming operations to be able to sponsor those employees that go above and beyond to be able to stay long term and remain critical team members.
